Introduction

→← Step 1

Surface Debris Removal

Over time, leaves, twigs, and other debris may accumulate on your lawn. Regularly clearing these helps maintain both the appearance and the drainage system.

How Often:

At least once a month.

Tools to Use:

Use a leaf blower or a **stiff wire brush** from The Modern Lawn Company's Cleaning Kit. The brush will help remove debris and lift the grass fibres back into place.



→← Step 2

Brushing the Grass

To keep your artificial grass pile upright and looking fresh, brushing is essential, especially in high-traffic areas.

How Often:

Once a month.

Technique:

Always brush **against the pile direction** using a stiff brush. This will help rejuvenate the fibres and prevent compaction.

Product Recommendation: Use the stiff wire brush included in our Cleaning Kit or purchase it separately from The Modern Lawn Company.

→ Step 3

Rinsing the Lawn

Hosing down your lawn during dry spells or after pet use will help prevent odour buildup and keep your grass clean.

For Pet Owners: Areas where pets frequently urinate may need rinsing more regularly with a hose. This helps dilute any odour-causing residues.

General Rinsing: We recommend rinsing the entire lawn with water during extended dry spells.

Tools: Our **Cleaning Kit** includes a **hose lance** perfect for easily rinsing the surface.



→ Step 4

Handling Pet Mess



Pet Waste:

Remove pet mess as soon as possible. After picking it up, rinse the area with soapy water or disinfectant to maintain hygiene.

Products:

We recommend using a pet-friendly disinfectant from The Modern Lawn Company for a thorough clean.

For homes with multiple pets, consider using **Zeolite granules** in your sub-base, which absorb and neutralise pet odours.





→← Step 5

Managing Weeds

Weed growth is rare, but small seeds can germinate on the surface if left unchecked.





Simple Removal:

Pull out any surface weeds by hand. For persistent weeds, you can use a water-based weed killer, but ensure it's safe for pets and children.

Preventative Care:

Regular brushing and debris removal will reduce the chances of weed growth.

→ Step 6

Protecting Your Lawn from Heavy Objects

It's safe to place heavy garden furniture, trampolines, and other items on artificial grass, but be mindful of compaction.

Move Regularly:

Shift heavy items slightly every few months to allow the grass underneath to recover.

After Moving:

Brush the grass to help it spring back into its original form.









Seasonal Care and Precautions

Hot Weather:

Do not place charcoal BBQs directly on the lawn. Use gas BBQs with enough clearance to avoid heat damage.

Fire & Cigarettes:

Be cautious of fire hazards - cigarettes and fireworks can melt the plastic fibres. Always provide ashtrays or smoking areas away from the grass.



→← Step 8

Avoiding Damage



Boiling Water:

Never pour boiling water directly onto the lawn as it can cause irreversible damage to the plastic.

Adhesives & Gum:

If chewing gum or sticky adhesives get on the grass, gently scrape it off. In some cases, it may need to be cut out.

Heavy Vehicles:

Avoid parking cars, motorbikes, or other heavy vehicles on the lawn for extended periods, as this can cause lasting compaction.
